They actively seek to gain experience as artists and performers, building a strong portfolio and foundation in preparation for future studies in dance and related fields.

The program boasts a rich history of excellence, with a strong emphasis on both technical proficiency and artistic expression. Students are encouraged to explore their own unique voices through dance, developing not only their physical skills but also their creativity and confidence. Hamilton Dance is more than just a program; it's a family. It's a place where students can discover their passion, develop their skills, and build lifelong memories. The program instills valuable life lessons such as discipline, teamwork, and perseverance, preparing students for success both on and off the stage.

This multi-talented artist's domain knows no bounds. He is equally at home in an intimate cabaret setting or a large concert stage which he has shared with many seasoned performers such as Alicia Keys, Erykah Badu, Deborah Harry, Billy Ocean, Dave Coz, and Stevie Wonder just to name a few.

Since 2004 Sire has received an endless demand for his Barry White Tributes. When he joined the Pleasure Unlimited Orchestra in Germany, he felt honored enough to be a temporary replacement but has continued performing as the frontman to date for sold-out concert halls in Europe and throughout since 2009. His flawless simulation has received rave reviews and earned him the title of The First International Barry White Tribute artist from the USA. He is now the proprietor of the Barry White Experience managed by Europolis Entertainment Productions.

Sire released a worldwide CD titled "Strong Enough" that contains his Royal Compilation of original Neo-Soul love songs and Electrifying Dance Mixes. Also, currently released special singles titled, "At Chrismas," "That Kind of Love" and "Just Stay" which reached No. 11 on the UK Soul Chart Breakers.

Sire has received mass acclaim after solo spot in national commercials for Little Caesars Pizza, Salesforce, TILE, and Discover Card featuring superstars like Jennifer Coolidge, Cardi B, and the hit music video, "2 Dollar Bill" with 2chainz, Lil Wayne and E40. Sire was sought out to guest star on TV shows such as the Tim and Eric Awesome Show "Great Job!" "To Tell The Truth", Jupiter Jones and his break-out role as SWAN on a new Disney series titled SATUR-DAYS with an amazing cast, such as rap legends, YoYo and the Dabrat, Golden Brooks, Omar
